

# Spiral Pendant Tutorial



## Materials List:

- One 8 inch Pieces 20 Gauge Round Wire
  - One 1 inch Round Bead
    - Round Nose Pliers
    - Needle Nose Pliers



### Step 1

- Start by bending the wire at a 90 degree angle 4 inches from either end.



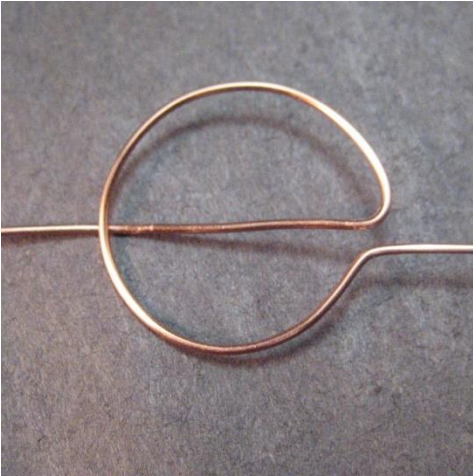
### Step 2

- Thread the bead on to either end of the wire.



### Step 3

- Wrap the longer end of the wire around the bead and bend at a 90 degree angle once the circle around the bead is complete.



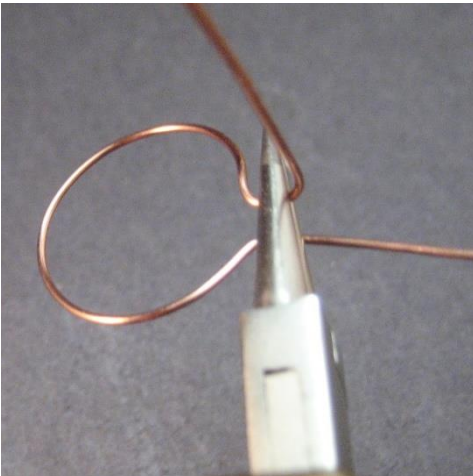
#### Step 4

- Remove the bead from the wire



#### Step 5

- Bend the wire that was through the bead so that it is parallel to the other end of the wire.



#### Step 6

- Grip the wires with the round nose pliers and bend the wire end at a 90 degree angle.





#### Step 7

- Wrap the wire around the round nose pliers just above the 90 degree bend from the last step to create a loop.



#### Step 8

- Bend the end of the wire away from the loop so it is parallel to the wire just below the loop.



#### Step 9

- Wrap the shorter end of the wire around the wires just below the loop three times.



#### Step 10

- Cut the tail off the wire just above the three wraps you created in step 9 and pinch tight with your pliers.



#### Step 11

- Thread the bead onto the wire.



#### Step 11

- Wrap the wire around the bottom wire below the bead.



### Step 12

- Bend the wire over the top of the bead.



### Step 13

- Coil the end of the wire around the round nose wires then continue to turn the pliers while gripping the wire to create a loose spiral.



### Step 14

- Press the spiral down so that it lies flat against the bead.
